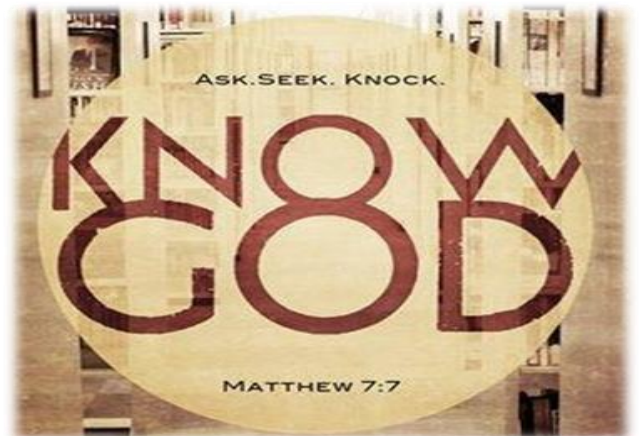

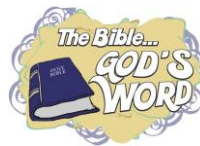

WHY DO WE. . . .

BLESS OURSELVES WITH HOLY WATER?

Because we entered the Church through baptism, the font is positioned at the Church's entrance. This is a sacramental gesture that has the potential to cleanse us of our venial sins. It's a gentle reminder that we've just entered a sacred area for a sacred time.

GENUFLECT?

"At the name of Jesus, every knee must bow." That was written many years ago by St. Paul. The priest and ministers make a genuflection as they approach the altar to remember Jesus' Real Presence in the Tabernacle Eucharist. The priest bows reverently to the altar and the cross if the tabernacle is not in the center of the sanctuary. When entering the Church and before sitting in their pew, the faithful should make a genuflection to the tabernacle. The tabernacle of the Most Blessed Sacrament should be readily seen. Look for the small glowing vigil light next to it.

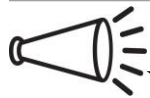
OUTREACH & EVANGELIZATION
